



2014 Coury Clone Pinot Noir

The Wine

Named after the man who stole the clippings in the middle of night, nothing says Hyland Pinot Noir quite like the Coury Clone. Our Coury pinot attacks with aromas of cherries and wild strawberries. The mouth is graceful and consistent year over year with tea and plum notes and a very noteworthy spice at the end which beautifully lingers on the palate seconds after each sip.

The Vintage

The 2014 vintage has the richness and power of 2012 but the restraint and balance of 2013. A cold and wet winter followed by a hot and dry summer led to an early harvest giving wines that are as vibrant as they are bold.
